- Small rug or mat
- Musical instrument
- Sewing kit
- Snacks in raccoon-proof container
- Survival kit (if taking Wilderness Survival MB)
- Camera (if taking Photography MB)
- Fishing pole and tackle (license if 17 or older)
- Jeans / leather boots (if taking Welding MB)

Not Suggested

- Cell phone
- MP3 player
- Other electronic devices
- Collections of value
- Other valuables

Do Not Bring

- Fireworks
- Firearms
- Valuables
- Alcohol or drugs
- Sheath / fixed blade knife
- Pets (including parents' night)
- Open toe shoes, except for shower
